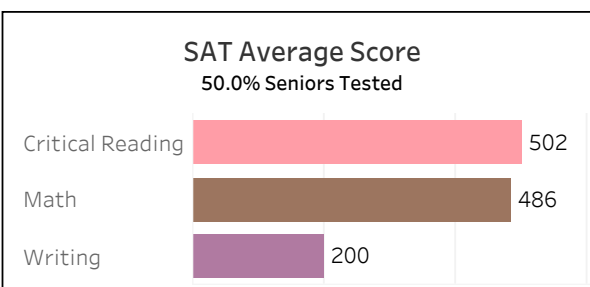

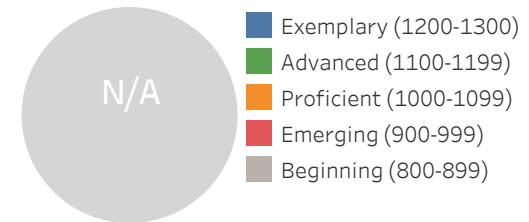

Students in Extracurriculars



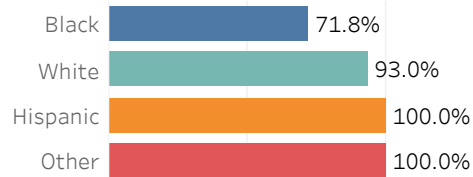

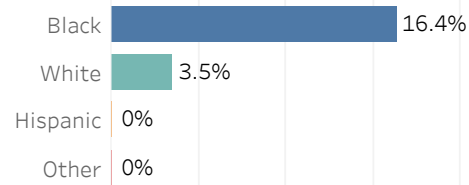
