

SPRINGFIELD ELEMENTARY



The new Springfield Elementary will complete the “Springfield Learning Community,” which also includes Montessori Community School and a shared Commons Building between the two school facilities. Construction on the new Springfield Elementary began in late fall 2014 and finished in late summer 2016 in time for the start of the 2016-2017 school year. The facility contains forty educational spaces, two computer labs, two project labs, and various support spaces. Covered walkways allow access to the adjacent Commons building that is home to the cafeteria, multi-purpose room, media center, and art/music spaces.

The facility is designed with open spaces and abundant natural lighting, energy efficient mechanical systems and the most current technology systems. The playground areas will be covered with synthetic turf material, thus reducing maintenance costs for the District. Once the former elementary school building is demolished, the site will be converted to a landscaped “Great Lawn” green space, also serving as an open play area for the students.
