**Charleston County School District Implemented New
Online Student Registration Process TODAY**

The Charleston County School District implemented a new online process for student registration. The online registration process opened today, July 27, 2016. This system will be utilized by:

- Students new to CCSD;
- Students with an approved transfer request;
- Students who have accepted a seat at a Choice school.

A Parent/Guardian account is needed to initiate the process. An email address is required to create an account. If an account was created during the School Choice or Student Transfer processes, then the same account will be used.
