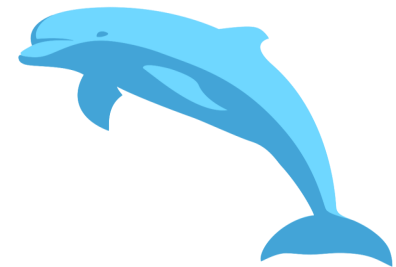
Purpose of Report:

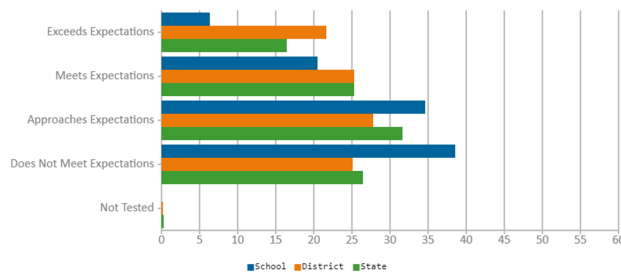

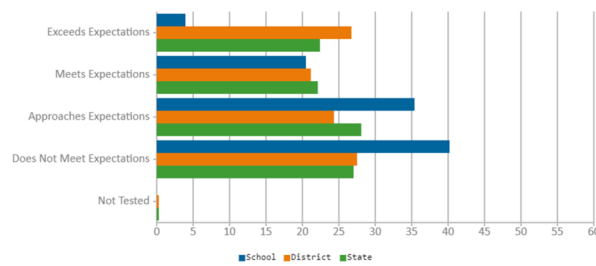

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing)



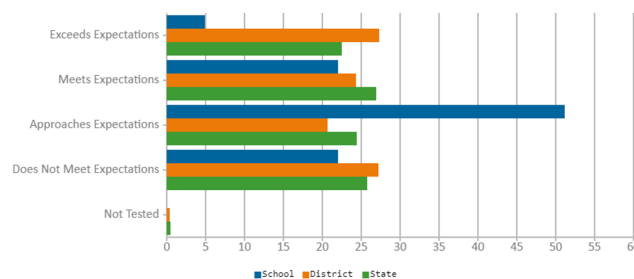

Mathematics



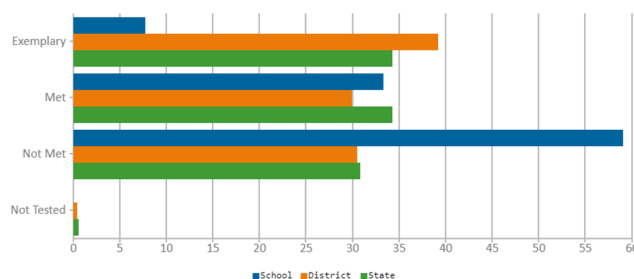
